Now in its fourth decade, the annual MOJA Arts Festival celebrates African-American and Caribbean arts and culture in Charleston, SC. This 11-day festival features presentations in a variety of artistic disciplines including jazz, R&B, gospel, dance, theater, poetry, storytelling, classical music, and visual arts alongside children's activities, heritage events and community traditions. MOJA's mission is built around the concept of building bridges of understanding and respect for the beauty of artistic and cultural expression among all parts of the community.

The **MOJA Arts Festival** is produced by the **City of Charleston Office of Cultural Affairs** in cooperation with the **MOJA Planning Committee** and is scheduled for **September 26 to October 6, 2019** in **Charleston, SC**. We are currently seeking artists and ensembles to apply to perform in the 2019 festival.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Successful applicants for past Festivals have used the application process not only to present their credentials and performance history, but also to frame a compelling and clear proposal for their participation in MOJA Arts Festival. Before starting your application, we encourage you to review a past program guide for reference about the scale and nature of offerings at MOJA, and then to articulate specifically what you would propose for the 2019 Festival.

Traditionally, the MOJA public planning committee invites the jazz and R&B headliners directly. Gospel performers have been selected exclusively from the Lowcountry area. We are always open to considering self-produced programs and concerts that complement the festival schedule.

Applicants may request to be a part of a particular series and may identify specific venues and performance dates in their proposals, although we do not guarantee we will be able to meet such requests. As such, no assumptions should be made about venue, performance schedule, or other specifics until a contract has been generated by the Office of Cultural Affairs.

In some cases, invited participating artists will enter into a presentation contract in which a mutually agreed artistic fee is paid to the artist without consideration of box office receipts. In other instances, a self-producing contract will be generated allowing the artist or ensemble to assume a greater financial risk while having direct participation in ticket sales revenue in lieu of a presentation fee.

Visiting MOJA performers assume responsibility for their own travel and lodging arrangements and all related expenses. Presentation fees can only be paid to artists following their performance, and producing companies should anticipate a turn-around time of fifteen (15) business days from the close of their engagement for agreeing a box office settlement, and then an additional twenty (20) business days for payment of net box office proceeds. Please anticipate these standard terms as you budget and plan for your proposed participation in the MOJA Arts Festival.
